Ribbon Cutting Cookie Recipe

Rita's Butter Cookies

- 3 sticks of butter, softened at room temperature
- 1 ¼ cup of sugar
- 3 cups of flour
- Pinch of salt
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon of vanilla

Cream the butter and sugar with an electric mixer. Gradually add flour and salt. Add egg and vanilla. Bake at 350 degrees about 7 minutes. Cookies are ready just before they turn brown around the edges. This recipe is great to use with a cookie press.
