Help save Monarch Butterflies

The Federal Government plans to spend millions in partnership with the National Wildlife Federation and the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation to save the monarch butterfly. The efforts will focus on six ways to save the monarch butterfly by: saving grasslands, supporting the Highway Habitat Corridor, planting milkweed, not using pesticides, creating monarch habitats, and joining NWF Affiliate efforts across the country. CFGC members can help by planting milkweed. Milkweed is the host plant for monarch butterflies. The larvae (caterpillars) of monarch butterflies eat only milkweed. There are vitamins in milkweed that allows the caterpillars to grow and transform into beautiful monarch butterflies. Transplanted Garden and Farmers Supply will have milkweed plants late April and May.
