

To find each app, simply go to the App Store (Iphone) or Play Store (Android) and search for "cape fear garden club". You will see Elizabeth Baker's name and our official logo - so that you know that you have the correct app. INSTALL!

Under the membership tab, there is a members-only area where you enter your CFGC website username and password to access the latest Yearbook information. With the photos, each member is able to edit his/her own data for the yearbook. No more need for the Computer Registrar to do these data corrections. However, the Computer Registrar will continue to process all membership status changes to the member database which populates the yearbook.

This is now an amazing resource for all of the Azalea Garden Tour ticket holders which allows them to get directions to parking and to the gardens in real time on their phones.
