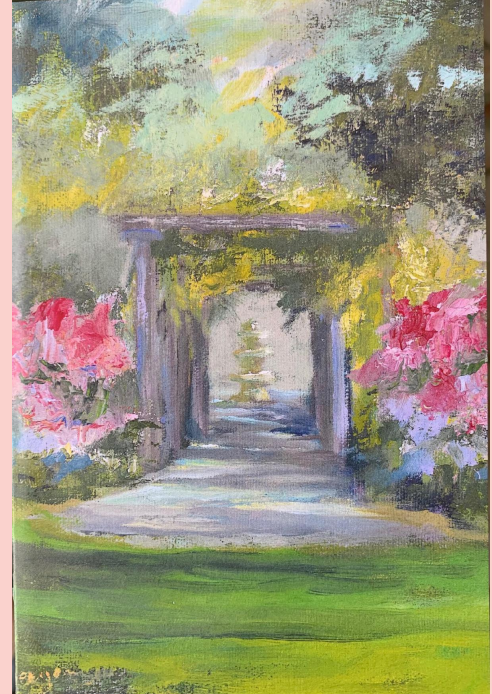

Centennial Snippet This is not the first time in our long history, that the Cape Fear Garden Club has had to cancel our beloved Azalea Garden Tour.

In 1954, the 2nd Garden Tour was canceled due to a severe frost which destroyed the blooms. Four years later, in 1958, severe weather again made it impossible to have the tour. The 1960 tour was canceled by “unusually bitter weather”. The Ribbon Cutting that year was to be at the garden of Mrs. Miriam Burns at 1417 Hawthorne Road. The Burns garden was on the first tour in 1953 and also many others over the years including the 50th Anniversary Tour in 2003. By then it was the home of her granddaughter and our member Mimi Burns Whitford and her husband Rick. ~Elaine Henson
